Audubon at Succop Nature Park is located at 185 West Airport Road in Butler, PA.

From the north, take Route 8 south from Butler for approximately 7 miles. Turn right onto West Airport Road. The Nature Park entrance is the first drive on your left.

From the south, take Route 8 north (I2 miles from the PA Turnpike) and turn left onto West Airport Road. The entrance to the Nature Park is the first drive on your left.


