WHY GARDEN WITH NATIVE PLANTS?

Is your garden your outdoor sanctuary? It can also be a haven for birds and butterflies! When you garden with native plants, your yard, patio, or balcony becomes a sanctuary for nesting and overwintering birds. Each native plant garden is a pocket of habitat—planting more gardens means we create a neighborhood of bird-friendly habitats.

Did you know that most landscaping plants available in local nurseries are from other parts of the world? They provide little value to our local insects and birds. Native plants provide food and shelter for native birds and other wildlife. Birds feed on the insects that evolved with native plants. When you plant an exotic plant in your landscape, it provides no benefit to wildlife.

Native plants also benefit people—allowing them to spend more time watching birds and less time with the hose and lawnmower. Because they evolved here, our native plants are adapted to our region. They don't need extra watering or nutrients.

You'll also see environmental benefits—mowers and weed-whackers burn 800 million gallons of gasoline per year, adding to greenhouse gases that drive climate change. Less mowing also means less water and noise pollution. According to the Environmental Protection Agency, 30 to 60 percent of fresh water in American cities is used to water lawns.

There are many reasons to choose native plants. But perhaps the best reason of all is that they're beautiful.
