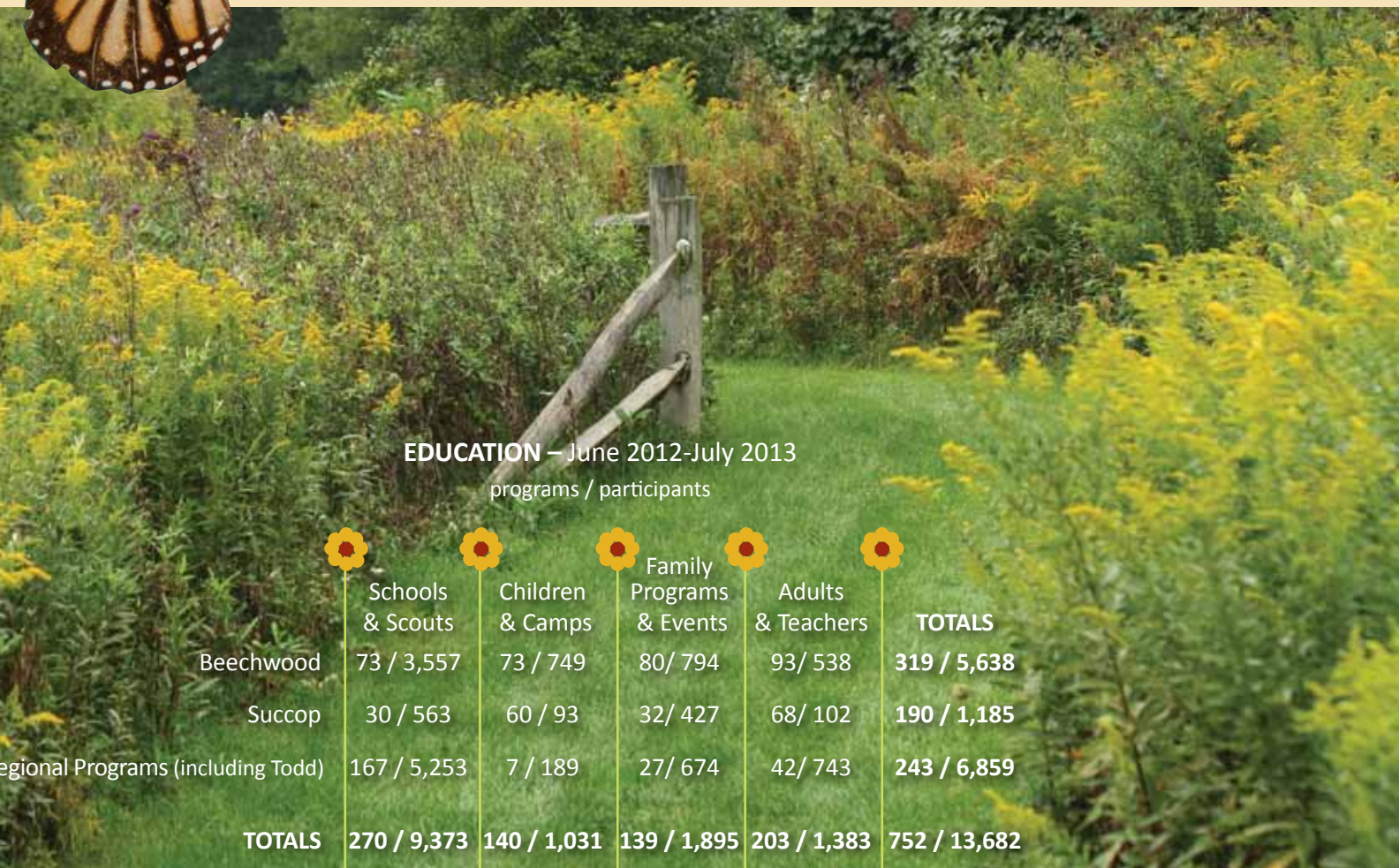

Making an Impact With Environmental Education






ASWP believes that getting people of all ages engaged with nature starts a life-long love of the environment.

- Program focus areas include: Birds as Ambassadors, Watershed and Water Quality, Experience in Nature, Humans and the Environment, and The Ecology of Western PA.
- Free/reduced admission to ASWP programs provided to Tickets for Kids, Salvation Army, Big Brothers/Big Sisters of Butler Co., Kids Count STAP Camp, and many other organizations throughout the region.
- Initiated new three-year, Kindergarten through sixth grade comprehensive environmental education program with Penn Christian Academy.
- Over \$30,000 in Environmental Education classes were provided by ASWP, free of charge to local schools through the Education Improvement Tax Credit program and the generosity of regional businesses.
- 94 teachers received ACT 40 Certified training through our Continuing Education classes.
- Provided 73 summer camp scholarships for children through our Shannon's Camp Fund in 2013. Proceeds from *A Night in the Woods*, our summer fundraiser, raised enough money for the camp fund to provide an additional 60 full scholarships in 2014.
- Audubon Center for Native Plants hosted 12 programs including Native Plant Container Gardening, Landscaping with Native Plants, Fall Seed Collection, Birds and Native Plants, Wreath Making, Starting Native Seeds, Composting, Wildflower Workshop, Get Your Garden Ready for the Season, and Rain Harvesting.

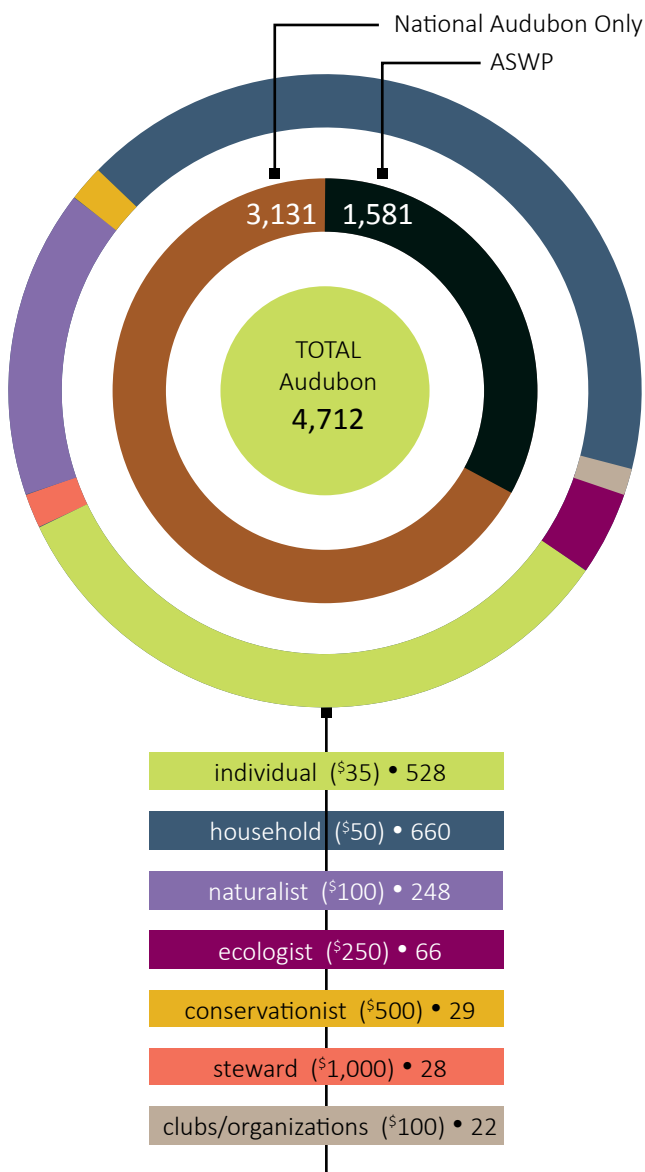

It's one of the most common comments we hear at Audubon, right after "that was a great program" and "we really enjoyed our visit to your reserve." Through our Programs, Projects, and Places, Audubon Society of Western Pennsylvania connects people to nature in many ways – from school visits and field trips to expert lectures and our national birding expedition program. We help people understand the role of native plants in our ecosystem, facilitate the installation of rain gardens and butterfly habitats, and work with researchers country-wide on Citizen Science projects. We meet with elected officials to help them understand complex environmental issues. And we continue our goal to build appreciation for birds as indicators of a healthy environment – a goal that began in 1916. This Annual Report details just some of the many activities we've been engaged in over the past year. We thank all of our members, supporters, and volunteers for making this possible.



MEMBERSHIP



Reaching into the Community

As the local leader in environmental education and conservation, we are committed to connecting people to birds and nature through our programs, projects, and places.

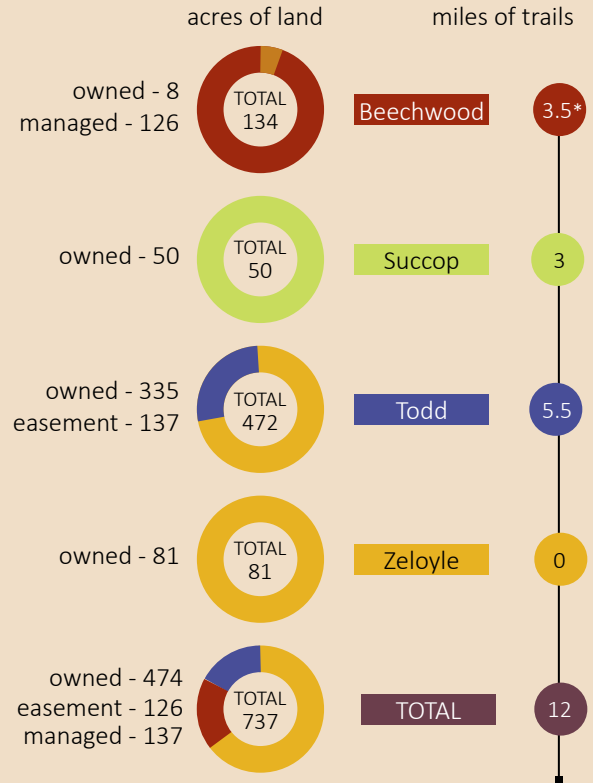
- 13,000 individuals took part in both formal and informal programs with ASWP – the majority of which (73%) were children.
- Over 10,000 students experienced our hands-on environmental programs.
- Over 350 formal and informal programs presented to adults and children, including field trips, educator workshops, and native plant seminars.
- Program offerings include weekly nature walks, early childhood and preschool parent/child programs, family nature outings, and evening programs.
- 53 complementary facility rentals were provided at Beechwood and Succop for community organizations, clubs and other non-profits over the past year.
- ASWP installed a Chimney Swift tower at Shaler Area High School, complete with a camera that allows web visitors to see the birds' movement. Monitoring the birds has also been integrated into Shaler Area School District's science curriculum.
- Hosted expert speakers: Bill Clark on Island Raptors; Marcia Bonta on Women in the Field: America's Pioneering Women Naturalists; Pete McQuillen on Green Burials; Derick Lovitch on How to be a Better Birder; and Jim Danzenbaker on The birds of South Georgia Island.
- Eco-Trips give people the opportunity to travel across the country on professionally-guided birding tours led by ASWP staff. In the past year, trips included the Rio Grand Valley and Montana.
- ASWP expanded its native plant gardens atop the D. L. Lawrence Convention Center. These gardens attract Monarch butterflies and provide a beautiful oasis in the middle of downtown Pittsburgh.

Engaging People: at our Reserves and Across the Region

Through our Citizen Science programs, underwritten by Dominion Foundation, we get people engaged in collecting data that helps scientists to monitor the health of our environment. The amount of data collected far exceeds what scientists could collect on their own, making these programs vitally important to scientific researchers. This year, ASWP expanded its Citizen Science programs to locations throughout our service region.

- 48 citizen science workshops allowed both adults and children to participate in projects that monitor the health of our environment.
- Programs included Firefly Watch, Lost Ladybug Project, Monarch Larva Monitoring Project, Project Feederwatch, Christmas Bird Count, and Great Backyard Bird Count.
- Programs were offered, free of charge, at Leechburg Public Library, Crooked Creek Environmental Learning Center, Saxonburg Area Library, Butler Area Public Library, Outdoor Classroom, Moon Parks and Recreation Community Center, Beaver Memorial Library, Westmoreland County Conservation District, Fern Hollow Nature Center, and Construction Junction.
- ASWP is the regional Christmas Bird Count leader, overseeing the Pittsburgh, Imperial, and South Butler counts and helping to promote all 10 Southwestern PA counts.

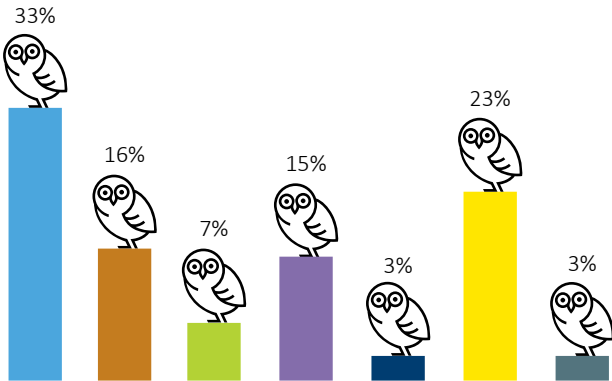

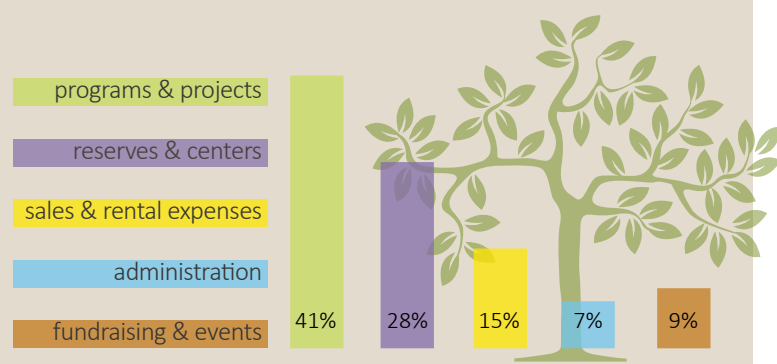


INCOME SOURCES

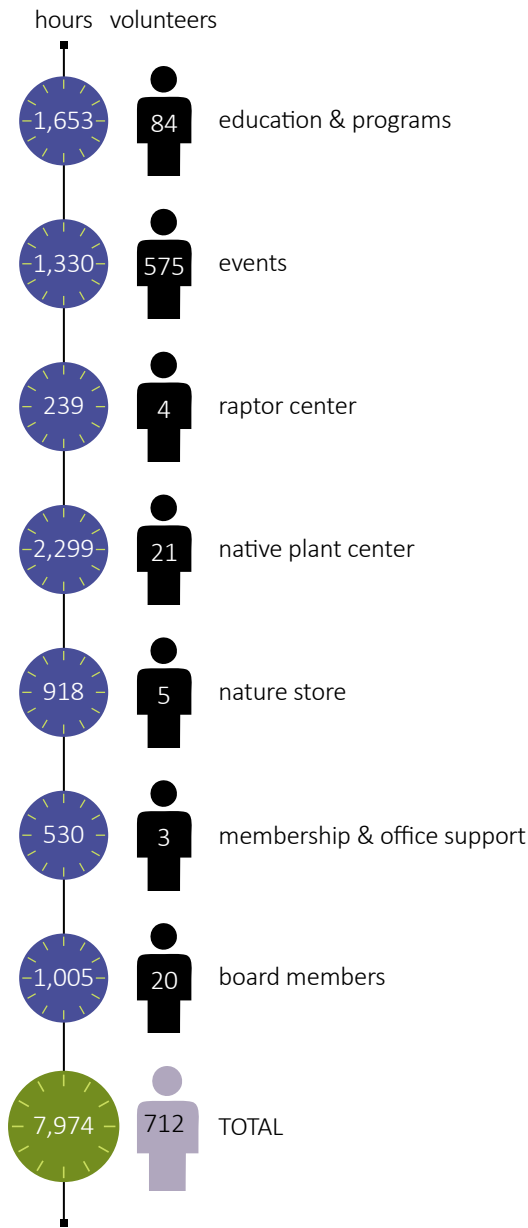
