To minimize travel and maximize the experience, we'll stay at the Jackson Lake Lodge, in the heart of the park, for the entire trip—no moving from hotel to hotel. The lodge's three onsite restaurants offer multiple dining options, and the indoor/outdoor lounge a stunning location to wind down in the evening.

This tour offers you the ability to choose how much birding you do, with optional early morning bird walks before breakfast. Morning excursions feature outings to view the park's birds and wildlife—these hikes will be planned according to recent sightings and trail conditions.

Looking for something more adventurous? There will be options for more hikes in the afternoons. You can customize each day to match your desiractivity level.

One day will be devoted to a visit to nearby Yellowstone National Park for can't miss destinations including Old Faithful and Yellowstone Lake.
